

St. Nectarios Greek School Parent and Student Expectations

We trust that students and parents together will meet the following expectations during the school year.

Students are expected to:

1. arrive on time and keep absences to a minimum; 12 or more absences during the school year is cause to remain in the same grade the following year.
2. bring necessary materials (books, supplies, homework) to every class.
3. display a positive, cooperative attitude which fosters learning.
4. be respectful of their priests, fellow students, teachers, and all others associated with the Church and the Greek school. Student behavior should not be disruptive to the teaching and learning process, or jeopardize the health and safety of anyone.
5. use appropriate and respectful language at all times.
6. be respectful of Church and school property and equipment and of the personal belongings of others.
7. keep mobile phones, iPods and all electronic devices out of the classroom; if found in operation on church property, the device will be confiscated by the teacher and can only be retrieved by the parent.
8. get the homework from another classmate or by calling the teacher when absent.

If a student is consistently unable to meet the above requirements, a meeting will be requested by the teacher with student and the parents. The next step will be a meeting between the parents, student and Principal Danae Spears. The final step will be a meeting with the student, parents, Principal Spears and Reverend Father Peter Balkas. The goal of these meetings will be to communicate and bring about positive changes for the student and the school. If there is no improvement following these steps, the dismissal of the student will be recommended.

Parents are expected to follow the rules and regulations of the school as stated in the school handbook, including the school security and illness policies. Parents are also encouraged to communicate openly with their child's teachers and the principal. Conferences with the teachers are held in November. If a parent feels an additional conference is needed or has a concern, please arrange a time to meet with the teacher and/or principal outside of regular school hours.
